Saturday 4 May - Bench Rest and Air Rifle#

Entry Fee \$25 which includes Lunch* (Sport Bench or Air Rifle add \$10)

- Shooting will commence at 8.30am. Entries will close at 10.30 am
- All bench rest competitions will be conducted as a 60 shot match (3 x 20)
- Bench targets will be the NSW SARAI 20 aiming marks, i.e. 1 shot per diagram plus unlimited sighters
- Time limit is 25 minutes per squad.
- Tied scores will be determined by the total number of centrals.
- Bench Rest is run in two competition formats:

Open Class

- ⇒ Unlimited scope power
- ⇒ Maximum scope and rifle weight: 8 kg
- ⇒ Graded event A 198.5 and above
B 196 to below 198.5
C Below 196
(In accordance with NSW SARAI gradings)
- ⇒ Verification of grade to be provided
- ⇒ Prizes awarded to the first 3 places in each grade including Tyro and Junior.

Sporting Class

- ⇒ Maximum scope power of 6
- ⇒ Maximum scope and rifle weight: 3.5kg
- ⇒ Prizes awarded to first place for off rifle and handicap
- ⇒ Handicap taken from any one of the 3 cards shot on the day.
- ⇒ A shooter winning a prize in the off-rifle is excluded from a prize for handicap.
- ⇒ Standard, "over the counter", uncustomised sporting rifle only may be used.

Sunday 5 May - Prone and Air Rifle#

Entry Fee \$25 which includes Lunch* (Air Rifle add \$10)

Event 1: 50m Prone

- Shooting will commence at 8.30am. Entries will close at 10.30 am
- This event will be conducted in A, B, C and D grades with prizes awarded to the first 3 places in each grade, including a Junior, Tyro and Teams (3 shooters from the same club) prize.
- The program will be a 60 shot English match with unlimited sighters.
- Time limit is 25 mins.

Conditions

1. Competitors must be registered members of the NSW SARAI or other association and hold a shooter's licence. Membership cards and shooters licence must be produced.
2. The Committee reserves the right to alter any program depending on the number of entries or weather conditions on the day.
3. A junior is a shooter who has not reached the age of 21 years on the day of the match and a Tyro is a shooter who has not won a prize at a prize shoot or championship.
4. ISSF Rules will apply except for clothing and time limits. NB the 2023 ISSF rules will not be enforced.
5. A team comprises any 3 shooters entered in only one team and registered with the same club.
6. Refund of entry fees will not be allowed unless the Committee deems such refund is appropriate and the competitor has not commenced shooting.
7. SSAA members will be accepted for the bench rest competitions.
8. Disabled shooters in the prone competition are not permitted to use any physical aids.
9. Shooters entering both Bench and Air Rifle on Saturday and Prone and Air Rifle on Sunday are to ensure that the 2nd competition is commenced prior to 1.00 pm.
10. Breach flags must be used before and after all competition.

10m Air Rifle (No air refill facilities available on the range)

1. A 40 shot match with 75 minutes time limit.
2. Prizes will be awarded to first place in A, B, and C grades.
3. N.B. There are limited entries for this event and squadding arrangements will be made on the day

*Lunch

Lunch will include a main item from the menu, unlimited drinks including soft drinks, water, tea, coffee cakes & biscuits. Guests of shooters pay \$5 for the same deal. If you are still hungry extra main items may be purchased for a fee - ask one of the ladies. BBQ facilities available for use.
