SQUADDING: Spaces on the 50m events are limited to 40 each day. *N.B Our volunteers will be shooting across the weekend. For scheduling purposes, the club will have 1 x 50m bay allocated for volunteers on each detail.*

Pre-bookings close at 6pm on 27th April. After the closing date, entry forms will be randomly drawn and squadding allocated based on preference in draw order. Squadding details will be available on the website from 28th April.

Walk-in's welcome on the day depending on space availability.

Please be on the range 30 minutes before the start of your squad.

CATERING: Lunch is included and is your choice of a sausage on a roll or cheese toastie, tea, coffee, cakes and biscuits. Extra main lunch items and cold drinks are available for purchase. Bring your own chair.

PROGRAM

Bench Rest & Sporter: Saturday 2 May

- Open bench rest will be conducted as a 60 shot match (3 squads), with a time limit of 25 minutes per squad, Sporter will be conducted as a 40 shot match (2 squads), with a time limit of 25 minutes per squad.
- NSW SARAI targets with 20 aiming marks i.e. 1 shot per diagram plus unlimited sighters. Once business shots are started no further sighting shots are allowed.
- Tied scores will be determined by the total number of centrals.
- Bench Rest is run in two competition formats:

Open Class

- ⇒ Unlimited scope power
- ⇒ Maximum scope and rifle weight: 8 kg
- ⇒ Graded event in accordance with NSW SARAI gradings
- ⇒ Verification of grade to be provided
- ⇒ Prizes awarded to the first 3 places in each grade also for Tyro, Junior and a team event (3 shooters from the same club)

Sporting Class

- ⇒ Maximum scope power of 6
- ⇒ Maximum scope and rifle weight: 3.5kg
- ⇒ Prizes awarded for 1st-3rd places (off-rifle)
- ⇒ Standard, "over the counter", uncustomised sporting rifle only may be used.

Prone: Sunday 3 May

- This event will be conducted in A, B, C and D grades with prizes awarded to the first 3 places in each grade, also a Junior, Tyro and a Team event (3 shooters from the same club) prize.
- The program will be a 60 shot English match with unlimited sighters.
- Time limit is 25 minutes per squad.

10 m Air Rifle (ISSF) Sunday 3 May

- A 40 shot match, on paper targets, with 15 minutes for sighters and 60 minutes for the match.
- Prizes will be awarded to 1st place in A, B, and C grades.
- N.B. There are limited entries for this event and squadding arrangements will be made on the day
- No air refill facilities available on the range

10 m Supported Air Rifle (AUFLAGE) Sunday 3 May

- A 30 shot match with a 45 minute time limit on electronic targets.
- The event will be divided into 2 groups: A & B Grade in 1 group, with all others combined to a second group. Prizes will be awarded to 1st -3rd place in each group.

CONDITIONS

1. Competitors must be registered members of the NSW SARAI or other association and hold a shooter's licence. Membership cards and shooters licence must be produced.
2. The Committee reserves the right to alter any program depending on the number of entries or weather conditions on the day.
3. A junior is a shooter who has not reached the age of 21 years on the day of the match and a Tyro is a shooter who has never won a prize at a prize shoot or championship.
4. ISSF Rules will apply except for clothing and time limits. 2026 ISSF rules will be followed but not necessarily enforced. 10m Supported Air Rifle will be conducted under TRA AUFLAGE guidelines.
5. A team comprises any 3 shooters entered in only one team and registered with the same club.
6. Refund of entry fees will not be allowed unless the Committee deems such refund is appropriate and the competitor has not commenced shooting.
7. Shooters entering both Prone and Air Rifle on Sunday are to ensure that the 2nd competition is commenced prior to 1.00 pm.
8. Breach flags must be used before and after all competition.
9. The Australian Supplementary Rules 2021 V1 for Open TRA Benchrest Target Rifle regarding stocks, A.24.6, will not be measured. A fair play policy will apply.
